HAVANA'S AUTHENTIC OLD TOWN.

Long isolated from visitors, Cuba's culture is among the most unspoiled in the world. In the mid 20th century, Havana was home to luxury resorts and casinos that attracted the likes of Frank Sinatra and Elizabeth Taylor. Today, the city seems frozen in time, its streets a fascinating blend of old-world architecture and 1950s Chevrolets and Fords. With an overnight stay in Cuba's capital, you will have time to immerse yourself in

Cuban culture and learn about its music, arts scene and architecture. Time in Cuba involves full days spent engaging in authentic experiences with the Cuban people—from hearing a local jazz ensemble to visiting an artist's studio. Together, you'll explore the city's neoclassical, baroque and colonial architecture that graces the atmospheric Plaza de Armas, Plaza de la Cathedral and other squares. Stroll the Avenida de los Presidentes and the Malecón waterfront.

THE PATH BETWEEN THE SEAS. When it opened in 1914, the Panama Canal was hailed as one of the world's great engineering feats. Forty-eight miles long, it links the Atlantic and Pacific at the narrowest stretch of the Isthmus of Panama, cutting thousands of miles off shipping routes. Crossing this manmade wonder, your ship will be raised and lowered through enormous locks at each end and you'll enjoy a scenic cruise on the 21-mile-long Gatun Lake.

PAPEETE, TAHITI. GAUGUIN'S PARADISE. One of the world's most visually stunning and romantic destinations, Tahiti is the cultural hub of French Polynesia. Its dramatic mountains skirted with swaying palms strike a breathtaking pose in shimmering Pacific waters. An overnight stay in Papeete's port lets you immerse yourself in its continental flavor. Admire the Cathedral of Notre Dame and browse the fascinating Paul Gauguin Museum, a rich collection of the work he created while living on the islands.

AUCKLAND. CITY OF TWO HARBORS.

Known as New Zealand's "City of Sails," Auckland enjoys a stunning setting between two harbors. Host of two America's Cup challenges, its marinas are brimming with world-class yachts. During an overnight stay here, you will have ample time to take in this Kiwi city's beauty and history, perhaps touring the tree-lined Albert Park and the neoclassical Auckland War Memorial Museum.



SHANGHAI, CHINA

SHANGHAI. ASTONISHING BLEND OF OLD AND NEW.

One of the world's most important ports, Shanghai is a modern metropolis and center of finance. It orbits around its famous and historic Bund, the city's elegant riverfront promenade overlooked by colonial-era banks and trading houses. Old Shanghai retains the narrow lanes and street markets of times past. An overnight stay allows time to stroll the inviting grounds of the dynastic Yuyuan Garden and browse the excellent collection of the renowned Shanghai Museum.



HAVANA, CUBA

SYDNEY. CULTURAL CAPITAL OF "OZ." Celebrated for its magnificent natural harbor, the world's largest, Sydney was founded as a penal colony in 1788. Since then, it has grown from a colonial settlement into the major cultural center of Australia. During an overnight stay, you will experience firsthand the all-embracing welcome of Sydneysiders and one of the most free-spirited cities in the world.

Admire the cultural jewel in Sydney's crown, the Sydney Opera House, the iconic UNESCO World Heritage Site nestled harborside like a gleaming white bird taking wing. Stroll the adjacent Royal Botanic Garden, one of the world's most important horticultural institutions. Explore The Rocks, a district named for the sandstone from which its original buildings were made. Today, its history-rich streets are complemented by crafts shops and markets.

BANGKOK. SIAM OF OLD. From our overnight port in Laem Chabang, you will have ample time to discover the revered temples (or *wats*) and traditional floating markets of Bangkok. Cultural and political capital of Thailand, Bangkok is beautifully set on the Chao Phraya River. A city tour reveals the towering Wat Arun on the river's banks and the temples of elegant buildings of the renowned Grand Palace, long home to the kings of Siam.

SINGAPORE. BUSTLING ISLAND NATION. Spread across 63 islands at the tip of the Malay Peninsula, Singapore is the world's only island city-state. The city was established in 1819 for the East India Company by Sir Stamford Raffles, after whom the city's famed hotel is named. The technology and economy are highly advanced here, yet the islands host plentiful green parks. Your overnight stay allows you to take in its sophisticated wonders, including the stunning National Orchid Garden.

BORA BORA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

MEDIEVAL MALTA. Layer upon layer of history can be peeled back on Malta, where a long succession of powers shaped the island's cityscapes and culture. Since Malta was an ideal crossroads for trade between Africa and Europe, the island gained tremendous wealth, and a mighty naval force emerged. Take in the medieval ambience of Valletta and Mdina, and let yourself be seduced by a stunning coast dotted with *luzzu* fishing boats, blue grottoes and sweeping bays.

GREENWICH. LONDON AT YOUR DOOR. The celebrated historic Royal Borough of Greenwich—part of which, Maritime Greenwich, is a UNESCO Site—is our gateway to London, the regal capital straddling the Thames. Old and new merge seamlessly here, from the Tower of London to the London Eye Ferris wheel. Today, London is one of Europe's great cultural centers; its history and politics come together at sites like the Parliament and Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace and St. Paul's Cathedral.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

As you start planning your *World Cruise* you may want to know more details, so below are answers to some questions that guests typically ask. If you do not see the information that you need here, you can also visit the My Trip section of our website at vikingcruisescanada.com/oceans, contact your Travel Agent or call Viking toll-free at 1-888-850-6261.

I've been told that I need to complete a Guest Information Form. What is that, and how do I take care of it?

The Guest Information Form is a critical form Viking needs on file before you travel. It enables us to create your reservation, produce travel documents and make any airline reservations. You should complete a Guest Information Form for each person traveling in your party as soon as you can. You can fill out the form by visiting myvikingjourney.com.

Do I need travel protection? While travel protection is not required, we do recommend it. Emergencies sometimes arise, and you want to protect your travel investment. When you purchase the Viking Cruises Travel Protection Plan within 14 days of your initial deposit/payment for your trip, you also receive the Viking Cruises Cancellation Waiver Benefit.

Is there a dress code? During the day on board and ashore, dress is casual including shorts, jeans and comfortable shoes for walking tours. Swimsuits, brief shorts, cover-ups and exercise attire should be reserved for the pool and Sports Deck. For evenings, while there are no "formal nights," the recommended dress is elegant casual for most restaurants, performances or other special events. Suggested attire for ladies includes a dress, or a sweater or blouse worn with a skirt or slacks; for gentlemen, trousers and a collared shirt. A tie and jacket are optional, but not required. Dinner in the The Restaurant remains casual, with daytime dress deemed appropriate.

Can you accommodate my dietary restrictions? In most cases we can. Every meal has vegetarian options and our chefs will make reasonable efforts to accommodate requests. Guests requiring special diets (low-salt, diabetic, gluten-free and low cholesterol) should alert us 90 days prior to departure and inform the Maître d' when on board.

Is the ship non-smoking? All Viking ship interiors, staterooms and balconies are nonsmoking except for the designated outdoor smoking area on the starboard side of Deck 8. Smoking restrictions also apply to e-cigarettes.

Do I need a passport and/or visa to travel with Viking? Passports valid for at least six months following your visit are required for all international travel. If you need to renew your passport, contact the National Passport Information Center (NPIC) at travel.state.gov.

For visa information, all guests including non-US citizens and green card holders should seek advice from their respective embassy, consulate or Travel Agent to determine which documents are needed prior to departure. Should you require a visa for your journey, please be aware that each country/embassy/consulate sets its own policies regarding their issue, so allow ample time for processing. Be sure to obtain and carefully review for accuracy all your required documents prior to departure to avoid delays, denied boarding/entry or additional cost.
