Grand Rivers of Europe Journey Highlights

Medieval Toll Booths

The castles along the Rhine Valley were originally constructed as fortified residences to protect the land from marauders—but castle owners also utilized their strategically advantageous positions to impose tolls on passing merchants. This may explain why you will see so many castles along the 35-mile stretch of the Rhine between Mainz and Bonn.

Ancient Heidelberg

Heidelberg is home to Germany's oldest university, founded in 1386. It also features one of the Rhine's most distinctive landmarks—the red sandstone ruins of Heidelberg Castle. Situated high above the town, the castle has sweeping views of the Neckar River Valley and of Heidelberg's red-roofed charm. Stroll along Heidelberg's narrow cobbled streets, shop in the stalls lining its wide squares, see the imposing gates of the Old Town area and walk across the town's famous Old Bridge.

Alsatian Cuisine

This region produces a savory cuisine that perfectly merges hearty German fare with French elegance. A typical dish is *choucroute*, featuring fermented white cabbage layered with spicy smoked pork—best served with potatoes and an Alsatian pinot blanc. Other meat specialties include *Baeckeoffe*, a traditional stew of marinated beef or lamb; charcuterie, sausages and other cured meats; goose liver pâté and Munster cheese.

Sensational Strasbourg

The multicultural city of Strasbourg, capital of France's Alsace region, owes its blend of French and German influences to its location along the Rhine River at the border between the two countries. Its historic city center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, features traditional wooden houses and picturesque canals. On your tour, see the carefully restored Cathedral of Notre Dame, most recognized for its graceful 465-foot-tall spires.

European Wine Regions

This itinerary takes you through several of Europe's famous wine regions. Enjoy the sundrenched white rieslings of the Moselle and Rhine region, the Franconian wines along the Main and the peppery Grüner Veltliners in the Wachau Valley. And, be sure to try the rich dessert wines of Hungary.

Bavarian Bamberg

Founded in 902, Bamberg's Old Town area is a beautifully preserved UNESCO World Heritage Site. Walk past neat rows of patrician houses to the remarkable Old City Hall, sited in the middle of the Regnitz River and accessed by bridges on both sides. Sample the town's famous smoky beer, *Rauchbier*.

Charlemagne's Dream

As far back as 1,200 years ago, Emperor Charlemagne contemplated connecting the Rhine, Main and Danube Rivers to facilitate river travel through Europe. Lack of technical resources prevented this idea from being realized—until the Main-Danube Canal was completed in 1992. Employing ingenious river locks, vessels can now travel 2,200 miles through 10 countries, from the North Sea to the Black Sea. The canal makes this journey possible.

Lucerne Extension 2 nights for \$599 per person

Extend your journey in picturesque Lucerne, Switzerland; enjoy the scenic landscape of the Swiss Alps with a view from your hotel, situated on the shores of beautiful Lake Lucerne. Two nights at the **Hotel Schweizerhof** (or similar), daily breakfasts, guided walking tour and ship/hotel transfer are included along with the services of a Viking host.

Hotel Schweizerhof is located right in the historic quarter of Lucerne, next to Lake Lucerne and was built in 1845. The hotel has two restaurants and a bar. The guest rooms have individually adjustable air conditioning and heating, a sitting area with table and chairs, desk with modem connection, mini-bar, direct-dial telephone, radio, cable TV with all major national and international stations, pay TV, LAN, guest information system, high-speed Internet access.

Budapest Extension Itinerary 2 nights—\$399 per person

Explore this legendary Hungarian capital, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its elegant boulevards, Parisian atmosphere and outstanding museums. Take a stroll in the parks of Margaret Island, discover the hidden medieval courtyards of the castle district and eat your fill of savory Hungarian cuisine. Extension package includes two nights at **Hilton Budapest**, daily breakfasts and hotel/ship transfers along with the services of a Viking host.

The moderate deluxe **Hilton Budapest** Hotel is located in the heart of the city's Castle District, a UNESCO Site, next to the Fishermen's Bastion and Matthias Church. The hotel has a restaurant, lobby lounge and bar; room service and laundry service; fitness room, a business center and gift shop. Rooms feature mini bar; television; telephone with voicemail; in-room safe and hair dryer.

Prague Extension 3 nights—\$699 per person

Extend your journey by discovering the Czech Republic's vibrant capital, the "City of a Hundred Spires." Three nights at the **Hilton Prague** (or similar), daily breakfast, panoramic city tour and the services of a Viking host are all included.
