See where old and new converge in Hanoi

Old and new combine in this unique Asian capital, set among lush parks and lakes. Visit the traditional Temple of Literature, then see the vast Ho Chi Minh Memorial. Pass beautiful Hoan Kiem Lake on your way to Hanoi's old town, where you explore the "36 Streets" by cyclo, the area's ubiquitous bicycle taxis.

Visit the ruins of ancient Angkor

Explore the remnants of the world's most extensive pre-industrial city. Begin with Angkor Wat, a UNESCO World Heritage Site so iconic that it appears on Cambodia's national flag. See the fortified city of Angkor Thom with Bayon Temple set in its center like a jewel; contemplate the mysterious smile on the massive stone faces of the bodhisattva Avalokiteśvara, keeping an eternal watch on the four compass points, and study the bas-relief scenes of legendary and historic events. Walk through the ruins of Ta Prohm Temple, festooned with massive tree roots. By way of contrast, spend an afternoon in the nearby provincial capital of Siem Reap.

Explore Phenomenal Phnom Penh

Walk off your ship, docked along the picturesque waterfront of Cambodia's capital city, and climb aboard a cyclo for your city tour. See the magnificent Royal Palace with its Silver Pagoda, built by 19th-century French colonialists but inspired by traditional Khmer architecture. Tour the infamous Killing Fields and the National Museum of Cambodia, which houses traditional Khmer treasures and art depicting the ancient empire.
