


Romantic Danube 2013 At-A-Glance

Explore both sides of Hungary's capital—traditional "Buda" and more cosmopolitan "Pest"—and from Fishermen's Bastion, see how the river divides this fascinating city. Experience Vienna's imperial architecture and gracious culture, and tour riverside towns in Austria's Wachau Valley. In Germany, explore a baroque cathedral and stroll cobbled streets lined with half-timbered houses. Savor the tastes of authentic dishes, learn about local legends, and understand why Strauss immortalized the "Blue Danube" in his famous melody.

Melk's Golden Abbey

As you sail along a peaceful stretch of the Danube, you approach a gold and ivory imperial fortress, resplendent with elegant details. Once a palace, the abbey at Melk is now a Benedictine monastery, school, museum and a library housing some 80,000 rare books and scrolls. See its interior, featuring soaring frescoes on walls and ceilings, and a glorious spiral staircase, on your tour.

Danube's Oldest City

Walk through Regensburg, one of Europe's best-preserved medieval cities. Founded by Marcus Aurelius over 2,000 years ago, its many architectural highlights include the 12th-century Old Stone Bridge and St. Peter's Cathedral with its Romanesque tower inside a newer Gothic one.

Austria's Wachau Vallev

The Wachau Valley is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, nestled between the quaint Austrian cities of Melk and Krems along the Danube River. Many picturesque towns and vineyards are located along this 24-mile stretch, and the area is perfect for leisurely sailing, taking photographs or just relaxing and enjoying a glass of one of its many local vintages.

Classical Music Capital

Known as the "City of Waltzes," Austria's capital of Vienna is widely considered to be the center of classical music. Here Strauss, Beethoven and Mozart composed many of their best-known works. Visitors can tour the homes of these famous composers and those of Haydn, Schubert, Brahms and more—now museums. Vienna still has a thriving music scene today.

Budapest Extension Itinerary 2 nights—\$399 per person

Explore this legendary Hungarian capital, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its elegant boulevards, Parisian atmosphere and outstanding museums. Take a stroll in the parks of Margaret Island, discover the hidden medieval courtyards of the castle district and eat your fill of savory Hungarian cuisine. Extension package includes two nights at **Hilton Budapest** or **Corinthia Grand**, daily breakfasts and hotel/ship transfers along with the services of a Viking host.

The moderate deluxe **Hilton Budapest** Hotel is located in the heart of the city's Castle District, a UNESCO Site, next to the Fishermen's Bastion and Matthias Church. The hotel has a restaurant, lobby lounge and bar; room service and laundry service; fitness room, a business center and gift shop. Rooms feature mini bar; television; telephone with voicemail; in-room safe and hair dryer.

The deluxe **Corinthia Grand** is located in the heart of Budapest within walking distance of the Opera House and major theaters. The hotel has three restaurants, a café, lobby lounge and bar; room service; laundry services; spa with indoor swimming pool, full-service business center; a beauty salon and gift shop. Rooms feature minibar; television telephone with voicemail; in-room safe and hair dryer.

Prague Extension Itinerary 3 nights—\$699 per person

Discover the Czech Republic's vibrant capital, the "City of a Hundred Spires". Tour Hradcany Castle and its palaces, churches and museums; visit Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral; and stroll along Charles Bridge. Explore Prague's Jewish heritage in the Josefov Quarter and encounter history and culture in Wenceslas Square. Extension package includes three nights hotel at the **Hilton Prague**, daily breakfasts and hotel/ship transfers, Prague city tour, along with the services of a Viking host.

The superior first class **Hilton Prague** is conveniently located on the right bank of Vltava River within walking distance from the city center and major attractions, and the bus and underground stations are only a five-minute walk from the hotel. The hotel has three restaurants, a bar and a wide selection of shops; a health club and spa offering a swimming pool, dry and wet sauna, jacuzzi, gym, health bar; beauty salon and other amenities. Air-conditioned rooms are equipped with a television, telephone, safe and hair dryer.
