Footsteps of the Cossacks Journey Highlights

Monastery of Caves

Founded by Greek Orthodox monks in the 11th century, Kiev's Monastery of Caves is an extensive complex of churches and museums encompassing bell towers, cathedrals connected by a network of underground passages and fortification walls. Together with the iconic domed St. Sophia Cathedral, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is a major center of the Eastern Orthodox faith. Explore the Cave Monastery—one of the Seven Wonders of Ukraine—and St. Sophia on your Kiev tour.

Cossack Culture

Spend a morning in Zaporozhye, ancestral home of the Cossacks. Learn about the history of this proud people at the Cossack Museum of Khortitsa, then enjoy a special show of Cossack horsemanship, music and dance. Back on board, sample Ukrainian tea and local treats.

The Year Was 1945

Travel along Yalta's Lenin Embankment to the Livadia Palace, site of the 1945 Yalta Conference between Franklin Roosevelt, Josef Stalin and Winston Churchill. Tour the official halls of this lovely Italianate palace, including the rooms where this famous meeting took place. Then, walk through the private apartments once enjoyed by Czar Nicholas and his family.

Khan Palace

Disembark in Sevastopol and proceed to the nearby Crimean city of Bakhchisarai. There you will tour the Khan Palace, built by Tatar khans early in the 16th century; within its walls are sumptuous living quarters, beautiful gardens, a harem, a mosque and a cemetery. Khan Palace is one of three Muslim palaces in Europe, the other two being Topkapi in Istanbul and the Alhambra in southern Spain.

Potemkin Steps

Made in 1925, Sergei M. Eisenstein's film "Battleship Potemkin" remains a cinematic classic. You may have seen a clip of its most famous scene, which takes place on Odessa's Potemkin Steps—which you will see for yourself on your tour.

The deluxe **Conrad Istanbul** is set in a prime location in the city center, adjacent to Yildiz Palace with stunning views of Istanbul. It is conveniently located near Dolmabahce Palace, the Grand Bazaar, Hagia Sophia and the shopping district. The hotel features a variety of restaurants, a lounge and bar; gym, sauna and massage services; indoor and outdoor swimming pools; tennis court; and 24-hour room service. Rooms include telephone, television, internet access, safe, minibar, hair dryer and coffee/tea making facilities.

Kiev Extension 2-night extension—\$499 per person

Experience Kiev's gracious architecture, public squares and landmarks, and explore the glorious, sprawling Saint Sophia Cathedral, a UNESCO World heritage site. Two nights at the **Radisson Blu** (or similar), daily breakfasts, guided walking tour and hotel/ship transfers are included along with the services of a Viking host; optional tours will also be made available.
