


Paris & the Heart of Normandy 2014 At-A-Glance

Normandy's Historic Beaches

See World War II landmarks such as Omaha Beach. Spend time at the Arromanches Debarkment Museum and pay your respects at the American Military Cemetery. On the way back to your ship, pass Gold Beach, Courseulles sur Mer and Juno Beach.

Monet's Famous Garden

French impressionist Claude Monet lived and worked in a stone farmhouse at Giverny from 1883 until his death in 1926. Art aficionados have seen the place, with its picturesque flowers, pond and bridge, many times in his paintings. Tour the house and spend time in the water garden, with its Japanese bridge, water lilies, wisteria and azaleas, that inspired so many priceless masterpieces.

Camembert and Calvados

Camembert—a soft, creamy cheese, traditionally aged for at least three weeks—was first made in Normandy in the late 18th century. When in northern France, sample this buttery delight at room temperature with a slice of French bread and a few grapes or apple slices. And speaking of delicious, try some calvados—a brandy made from the plentiful local apples, which also produce a wide variety of ciders.

Eiffel Tower

Visible from most points in Paris, the Eiffel Tower was built and used for the 1889 Paris Exposition. Ten years later it was nearly torn down, but was saved because of its useful radio antenna. Now it is the most recognizable symbol of Paris. Ride the elevator to the top to catch remarkable views of the city.

Paris Extension

3 nights—From \$699 per person

Start or end your vacation in Paris; experience the romance of France's capital city. Three nights at the **Crowne Plaza Paris République** (or similar), daily breakfasts, guided walking tour and hotel/ship transfer are included, along with the services of a Viking host.

The first class **Crowne Plaza Hotel Paris-République** is a unique building easily accessible and only a few minutes away from all attractions (Grands Boulevards, Montmartre, Eiffel Tower, etc.). Parisian people love going around to the numerous bars, restaurants and shops that surround the Place de la République, which is easily reached by five metro lines. The hotel has a restaurant, café and bar; room service; and a fitness center. Air-conditioned rooms are equipped with telephone and voicemail, television, internet service, safe, minibar and hair dryer.

Oxford & Highclere Castle (The Real *Downton Abbey*) 3 nights— From \$ 1,399 per person

Spend three days in the rolling hills of England's countryside. Visit the historic town of Oxford and Oxford University. Tour Highclere Castle, known to television audiences worldwide as *Downton Abbey*, with privileged access and a champagne welcome for Viking guests. Included tour to Blenheim Palace and the Cotswolds. Three nights at a centrally located deluxe Oxford hotel, daily breakfasts, three tours and a Eurostar "Chunnel" train between Paris and London are included with the services of a Viking host.
