Portugal's River of Gold Journey Highlights

Lisbon

Older than London, Paris or Rome, the vibrant city of Lisbon has very deep roots. Celts, Romans and Moors have left their traces here, and Vasco da Gama set sail for his epic voyages of discovery from the banks of the Tagus River. Much of Lisbon's old city dates back to the age of the naval heroes, and during your tour you will see such sights as the Belém Tower, the Jerónimos Monastery and the Monument to the Discoveries, all of which commemorate Portugal's past.

Porto

Portugal's second city is known for its beautiful old city center, its dramatic location on the banks of the Douro River and, perhaps more than anything else, its famous port wine, which made the vineyards of the Douro Valley known around the world. During your tour, all different aspects of this scenic gem will be explored, including a port wine cellar, where you will have the opportunity to learn about Porto's most famous export while sampling it at the same time.

Alto Douro River Valley

Wine has been produced by traditional landholders in the Alto Douro region for some 2,000 years. Since the 18th century, port wine has contributed to the country's wealth as it came in demand throughout the world. This long wine-growing tradition has resulted in a landscape of outstanding beauty that is unique in Europe.

Lamego

The town of Lamego, while scenic in its own right, is know in particular for its pilgrimage church of Sanctuary of Our Lady. Situated on a hill high over the Douro River, this magnificent baroque edifice towers over a spectacular staircase, decorated with the typical Portuguese *azulejos*, panels of blue on white tile depicting various biblical scenes.

Salamanca

Home of the oldest university in Spain, Salamanca is still considered the cradle of the Spanish language and it retains a college-town atmosphere. Its beautiful buildings and its intact urban landscape earned it the UNESCO World Heritage Site designation. During your visit, you will have a chance to explore the city's ancient streets and listen to Spain's traditional flamenco music.

Mateus Palace and Gardens

Italian architect Nicolau Nasoni was responsible for the design of this beautiful palace, completed in the 18th century for a wealthy family of wine growers. Along with its gardens, it is one of the most beautiful small baroque palaces in all of Europe.
