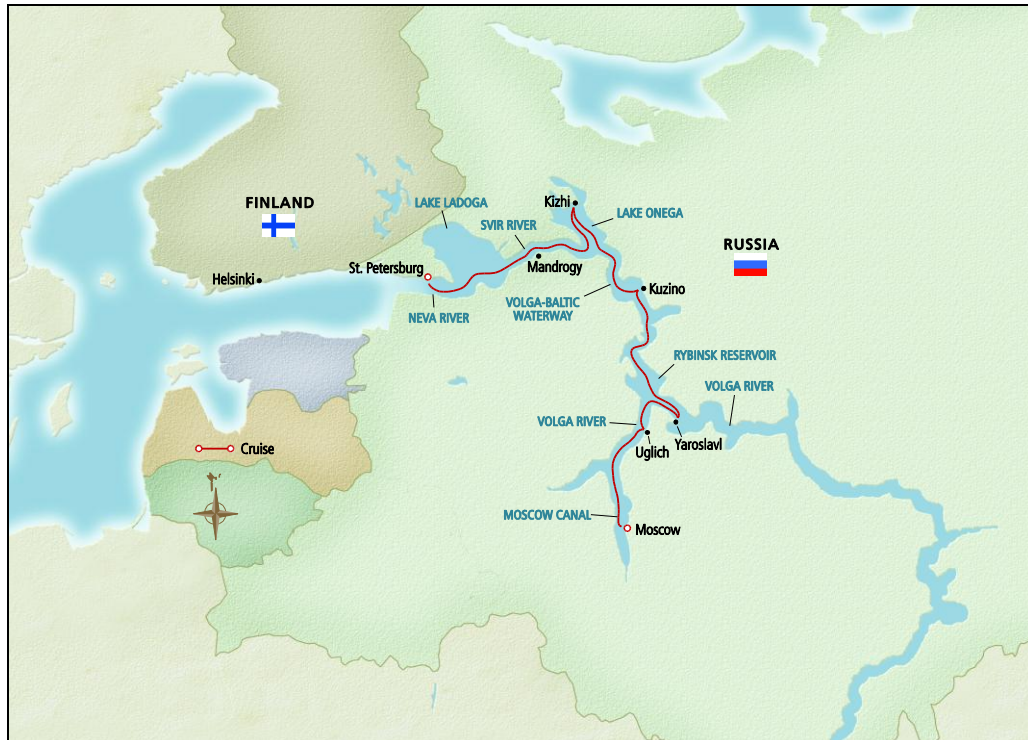

Waterways of the Tsars **Journey Highlights**

The World's Largest Art Museum

Over the span of 250 years, the collection of the State Hermitage Museum in St. Petersburg, Russia, has grown to over three million items including works from noted artists such as da Vinci, Michelangelo, Matisse, Rubens as well as Cézanne, van Gogh and Picasso. These treasures are housed along the embankment of the Neva River, in the heart of St. Petersburg. The highlight in this architectural ensemble is the Winter Palace, former residence of Russian Tsars including Catherine the Great—just one of the works of art you'll see on your tour.

An Architectural Feat

Once you arrive at the island village of Kizhi you will set out on a walking tour through the Open Air Museum of Architecture. Here, you will see ancient wooden houses, windmills and churches, highlighted by the famous three-tiered *Preobranzhenskaya* (Transfiguration) Church. This fairytale structure was built in 1714 without the use of a single nail.

The Heart of Moscow

In Russian, the word *kremlin* refers to any major fortified complex. But in Moscow there is one very special Kremlin, adjacent to Red Square. Inside its crenellated red brick walls you will see four palaces and a variety of churches, monasteries and official buildings—as well as one enormous bell. It also serves as the official residence of Russia's President.

A Legend Restored

Constructed of amber panels backed with gold leaf and mirrors, the Amber Room was given to Peter the Great by a Prussian King in 1716. Installed at Catherine's Palace in Pushkin, it was later extended to cover nearly 600 square feet with over six tons of amber. During World War II, German soldiers disassembled the room and it was never seen again. In 2003, a painstaking reconstruction was completed, enabling visitors to once again enjoy its brilliance. Admire it on your palace tour.

Russian Specialties

A large country, Russia has quite a varied cuisine—but some things everyone loves. A staple of the Russian diet is *pirozhki*, small pastries stuffed with fish, meat, eggs, potatoes, cabbage or mushrooms and either baked or quick-fried. Another traditional dish is *blini*, thin crêpe-like pancakes served with butter, sour cream, fruit preserves and/or caviar. Taste these specialties on board.

Helsinki Extension

3-night extension—\$799 per person

Extend your journey with a stay in Helsinki, Finland. See the city's highlights, including Senate Square, the Government Palace and the landmark Cathedral, and explore its noted museums. Transfer from St. Petersburg, three nights at the **Radisson Blu Plaza** (or similar), daily breakfasts and a guided walking tour are included along with the services of a Viking host.

The superior first class **Radisson Blu Plaza** hotel is in the heart of Helsinki, located conveniently next to the Grand Casino Helsinki, Finnish National Theater, Museum of Contemporary Art and Central Railway Station. The foundation stone of the building was laid in 1917 and today various parts of it are protected by the Helsinki City Museum, including some beautiful painted glass windows. The hotel offers a restaurant and bar; laundry service; a fitness room and sauna; business center and free wireless access. Air-conditioned room amenities include telephone, television, wireless internet access, safe, minibar and hair dryer.

Moscow Extension Itinerary

2 nights—\$599 per person

Extend your trip with two additional days in Russia's capital city. You will enjoy a guided tour through the city's famed subways and have free time to explore museums and the local culture. See the country's national treasures at The Armory or delight in a meal at the Pushkin Café, located inside a baroque mansion. Two nights at **Radisson Royal Hotel** (or similar), with daily breakfasts and hotel/ship transfers are included with the services of a Viking host.

Radisson Royal Hotel is a five-star luxury hotel in Moscow city centre, on a bend of the Moskva River. The hotel was originally built in 1953 and was the tallest hotel in the world at the time of construction. This hotel offers free WiFi, a library, a spa and concierge services. Air-conditioned room amenities include telephone, television, wireless internet access, safe, minibar and hair dryer.

St. Petersburg Extension Itinerary **2 nights—\$599 per person**

Spend two additional nights in magical St. Petersburg and visit the various palaces in this city. Enjoy a canal cruise and see why St. Petersburg is considered the “Venice of the North.” Or perhaps investigate the scene of Rasputin’s murder at the Yusupov Palace. Two nights at **Angleterre Hotel** (or similar), with daily breakfasts, hotel/ship transfers are included with the services of a Viking host.

The **Angleterre Hotel** was one of the first hotels in St Petersburg. In the 1920s it was a favorite destination for artists and poets. From its charming location overlooking St Isaac's Cathedral, it is perfectly placed for discovering the history and romance of the city. The hotel has the Borsalino Restaurant and Caviar Bar; spa, indoor pool, solarium and gym. All rooms are air-conditioned and offer a personal electronic safe, refreshment centre and hairdryer. The state-of-the-art interactive satellite television system includes internet as well as Video- and CD-on demand.
